Wiring and Termination Process Cable Preparation: Position the incoming fiber cable at the ODF's cable fixing plate. Strip the outer sheath carefully, exposing the fibers and reinforcing core. Wrap the ground wire around the steel tape of armored cables for grounding . Splicing: Place individual fibers into the splice tray. Fusion or mechanical splicing connects the incoming fiber to a pigtail, which then routes to the adapter panel . Adapter Connection: Insert the pigtail ends into the ODF adapters. Each port typically supports one fiber strand, totaling 24 cores. In high-density LC Quad configurations, each port can handle four fibers, allowing up to 96 fibers in the same 24-port frame . Cable Management: Use the integrated trays and guides to maintain proper bend radius (usually 30° obliquity for adapters) and prevent fiber damage. Secure cables with cable ties and protective PVC hoses where necessary . Labeling and Documentation: Mark each fiber and splice for easy identification and maintenance. This ensures efficient troubleshooting and network management . Best Practices Maintain bend radius: Avoid sharp bends to prevent signal loss or fiber breakage. Use strain relief: Secure cables to prevent tension on splices and adapters. Modular operation: Pull out individual splice trays for easier maintenance...
