- Surge Protective Devices:** Protect against voltage spikes from lightning or phase-to-phase faults.
- DIN Rail:** Standardized rail for mounting modular devices like breakers and contactors.
- Indicators and Switches:** LEDs or other indicators show circuit status, while switches allow manual control.
