Ensure political stability and peaceful coexistence. Facilitate regional cooperation in areas like environment, counter-terrorism, and technical research . Support free movement of goods, services, and people within the region. Economic and Demographic Significance Collectively, ASEAN has a population exceeding 622 million and a GDP that ranks among the largest in the world, with projections to become the fourth-largest economy by 2050 .
