Proper cleaning involves: Using Clean Dry Air (CDA) to remove loose particles. Applying spectroscopic-grade methanol on lens tissue to clean end faces. Handling fibers with lint-free gloves and avoiding contact with surfaces or bending the cable excessively. Inspecting cleaned surfaces under high-intensity light or magnification to ensure no residue remains. Covering connectors immediately after cleaning to prevent recontamination. Environmental Control Environmental factors significantly affect fiber performance. Key practices include: Maintaining temperature between 18–27°C and humidity at 40–60% to prevent micro-bending losses. Implementing dust control with high-efficiency air filters and regular replacement. Using anti-static cleaning tools for floors, cable channels, and patch panels in data centers. Ensuring proper airflow in high-density cabling areas to prevent heat accumulation and dust buildup. Inspection and Performance Monitoring Routine inspections should be conducted monthly, quarterly, or semi-annually, depending on network criticality. Activities include: Testing backbo...
