- Branch Circuit Wiring:** Each output load is connected to a dedicated MCB. Special loads may require double-pole MCBs.
- Grounding:** Ensure all metallic parts and neutral bars are properly grounded to prevent electric shock.
- Cable Management:** Maintain neat wiring, proper insulation, and correct wire gauge for each circuit. Leave space for future expansion ().
- Labeling:** Clearly label each breaker to identify the circuit it controls, aiding maintenance and troubleshooting ().
