

Aerial optical cable joints should be located next to the pole



Overview

The optical cable joint shall be located at the straight pole in which cables are easy to maintain, and the reserved optical cables shall be fixed on the pole with the reserved brackets. Aerial installation is generally much less costly than underground construction also. Fiber in a duct solutions have a major aesthetic. Some of the common tools include aerial storage for cables; telescoping poles; fiber heat shrink tube; brackets; blocks; cable saddles; fiber suspension clamp; cable rings, horizontal fiber splice closure, dome fiber splice closure, fusion splicers, etc. These cables are called aerial fiber cables and are commonly used for outside plant (OSP) installation on poles. That makes it quicker to deploy and easier to inspect, but the cable must withstand wind, ice, UV exposure, vibration and occasional mechanical abuse.
