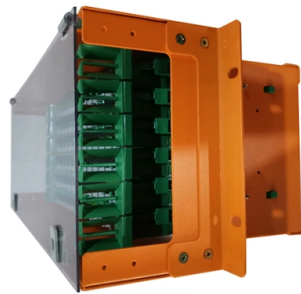


Analytical Errors of Spectrometers
