

Busbar junction box installation

Inspect components: Check that busbars, bolts, and junction boxes are clean, dry, and free of damage ().

Installation Steps

Plan the layout: Determine the optimal placement of the junction box relative to the busbar system, ensuring proper clearance from live components and accessibility for maintenance ().

Align busbars: Remove protective covers and align the busbar ends with the junction box terminals. Ensure large alignment parts match large slots and small parts match small slots ().

Secure connections: Tighten adjunct bolts to the recommended torque (e.g., 83 Nm) to ensure a firm electrical connection. Attach bolt protection lids and lower/upper lids as specified ().

Pour insulating resin (if applicable): For cast resin systems, pour the resin mixture over the conductors in the aligned junction box until the maximum level is reached, then secure the lid ().

Connect electrical wires: Attach outgoing and incoming conductors to the busbar terminals, using conductive grease for aluminum busbars to prevent oxidation ().

Check alignment and tightness: Verify that all bolts are properly tightened, the busbar is seated correctly, and the junction box is securely mounted ().
