

CIF Price of 380V Hybrid Energy System Exported from Switzerland

Estimating CIF Price

To estimate the CIF price: $\text{CIF Price} = \text{FOB Price} + \text{Freight} + \text{Insurance} + \text{Export/Import Duties} + \text{Additional Costs}$

For example, if a 380V hybrid system costs CHF 50,000 in Switzerland, shipping is CHF 5,000, insurance CHF 1,000, and import duties 5% (CHF 2,500), the CIF price would be approximately: $\text{CHF } 50,000 + \text{CHF } 5,000 + \text{CHF } 1,000 + \text{CHF } 2,500 = \text{CHF } 58,500$
