Maintenance vs. improvement: Routine maintenance or minor repairs are typically expensed, while significant upgrades or new installations may be treated as capital expenditures. Auditing: Tracing ensures that cable installation costs recorded in the accounting system match invoices, purchase orders, and work authorizations, helping detect errors or omissions.
