Notes on Selection and Weight:

- Cable Fill Ratio:** NEC Article 392 limits tray fill to ensure ventilation and prevent overheating. Typically, trays are filled to 40-50% of cross-sectional area for safety.
- Material Thickness:** Galvanized steel or aluminum thickness affects both weight and load capacity. Heavy-duty industrial trays often use 2.5mm+ thickness with reinforced rails.
- Length:** Standard sections are 3 meters (10 feet) for ease of transport and installation.
- Weight Estimation:** Weight per meter depends on tray type, width, depth, and material. For example, a 150mm wide, 50mm deep ladder tray with 2mm steel typically weighs around 5-7 kg/m, while a 900mm wide heavy-duty tray can exceed 25 kg/m.
