Common types include rigid metal conduit (RMC), intermediate metal conduit (IMC), and electrical metallic tubing (EMT). Conduits are preferred in high-risk environments, outdoor installations, underground runs, or areas with heavy equipment where cables need maximum protection. They also provide a longer lifespan and act as a Faraday cage to shield against EMI. Tray Cable vs Conduit Installation Tray cables (TC, TC-ER) are designed for use in cable trays and can often be installed without conduit, provided they are secured and protected from mechanical damage. Conduit may still be required in outdoor, underground, or hazardous locations, or where additional protection is mandated by code or the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ). Installation steps for both systems generally include: Approval of drawings and materials Site inspection and preparation Safety barriers and signage Inspection of trays, conduits, and accessories Identification of feeders and branches Adherence to approved shop drawings and standards Verificati...
