- Horizontal tee or cross: 1.0–1.5 man-hours per fitting.
- Reducer or drop-out: 0.5–1.0 man-hours per fitting.
- Installation of covers or separators: 0.1–0.3 man-hours per meter.

These values are indicative and should be adjusted for project-specific conditions, such as tray material (steel, aluminum, fiberglass), support spacing, and labor skill level.

Fabrication Considerations Fabrication quotas include cutting, bending, and assembling tray sections: Pre-fabricated sections reduce on-site labor and improve productivity. Custom bends or field modifications increase man-hours. Galvanized or stainless steel trays may require additional handling due to wei...
