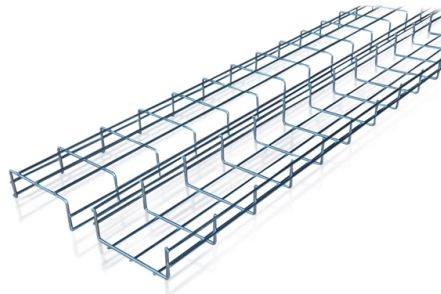


Cable tray installation and fixing angle iron bracket

Fixing Hardware Use high-tensile bolts, washers, and nuts, commonly M8 size, to secure the brackets to the wall or support structure. Ensure that all hardware is tightened properly to prevent movement but avoid over-tightening, which could deform the bracket or tray. Support Spacing Maximum support spacing depends on the tray type and load. For standard ladder or tray systems, center-hung supports typically allow a maximum spacing of 3.6 meters, with a maximum load per hanger of 318–340 kg. For heavy-duty or armored cables, reduce spacing to prevent sagging and maintain stress-free cable routing. Installation Procedure Mark the mounting points on the wall or ceiling according to the tray layout. Fix the angle iron brackets using appropriate anchors or bolts, ensuring they are level and aligned. Place the cable tray on the brackets and secure it with tray clamps or bolts. Ensure the tray is horizontal and free from twisting. Check alignment and load distribution before laying cables. Adjust brackets if necessary to maintain uniform support. Safety and Best Practices Only use trays and brackets designed and tested as a system; do not use trays as walkways or for supporting personnel. Ensure cables are stress-free and properly clamped at intervals (e.g., every 1 meter for hig...
