

Cable tray installation and fixing methods

Planning and Tray Selection Before installation, plan the cable tray route considering site layout, clearance, and load capacity. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load. Rung spacing for ladder trays is generally 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) to maintain cable support and prevent sagging. Trays should be aligned straight and level, with connectors and fittings properly secured.

Cable Fixing and Routing Cables should be laid in an organized manner, avoiding excessive bending to prevent insulation damage. Maintain proper separation between high-power and low-power cables to reduce electromagnetic interference. Use markers for cable identification to facilitate maintenance, and ensure cables are fixed at regular intervals to prevent movement and stress. Minimum bend radius must be observed when cables exit the tray.

Clearance and Accessibility Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access. Cable trays should not be installed in hoistways or enclosed spaces and must remain accessible for inspection and upgrades.

Grounding and Bonding Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors (EGC) if they meet NEC requirements. Proper bonding ensures electrical safety and reduces the risk of shock or fire.
