

Cable tray sleeve quota dimensions



AI Overview

Cable tray sleeve width and height are standardized to ensure proper cable fill, ventilation, and load capacity, with widths ranging from 6 to 48 inches (150–1200 mm) and heights (side rail or tray depth) from 3 to 6 inches (75–150 mm) depending on tray type and application.

Width of Cable Tray Sleeves The width of a cable tray sleeve is the internal usable width that determines how many cables can be accommodated. Standard widths vary by region and tray type:

- US/NEMA standards: 6, 9, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42, and 48 inches ().
- IEC/International standards: 50, 75, 100, 150, 200, 225, 300, 400, 450, 500, 600, 750, 900, and 1000 mm ().

Wider trays are preferred for large power or solar DC runs to reduce cable stacking, improve airflow, and simplify cable pulling ().

Height (Side Rail or Tray Depth) The height of a cable tray, often called side rail height or tray depth, controls vertical stacking capacity and affects heat dissipation and NEC fill compliance.

- US/NEMA practice: 3, 4, 5, and 6 inches ().
- IEC/International practice: 25, 50, 75, 100, 125, and 150 mm ().

The load depth is the internal dimension of the tray, while the side rail height is the external height used for quoting and structural considerations (). Increasing depth does not always increase usable capacity efficiently; often increasing width is more effective for airflow and cable management ().

Quoting Considerations When requesting a cable tray quote, the following dimensions are typically specified ():

- Width of tray – internal usable width.
- Side rail height – external height of the tray.
- Load depth – internal height for cable fill.
- Length of tray – standard straight section lengths.
- Bottom style – ladder, perforated, or solid.
- Fitting type and radius – for bends, tees, or crosses.
- Covers and accessories – if required. Each tray section and fitting comes with splice plates and hardware, with the number of pairs depending on the fitting type ().
