

Cable tray staircase construction

Common support methods for staircases include wall-mounted brackets along stringers or trapeze hangers for suspended sections. Install supports at regular intervals to maintain stability and prevent sagging.

Step 4: Mount Cable Trays Position the cable trays along the staircase, aligning them with the supports. Secure trays using bolts, clamps, or brackets as specified. Ensure the trays follow the staircase angle smoothly, maintaining consistent spacing and avoiding sharp bends that could damage cables.

Step 5: Cable Routing and Fill Identify the types of cables to be installed and calculate the maximum fill area according to NEC 392.22. Route cables carefully through the trays, using rollers or sheaves for long runs to prevent abrasion. Avoid overfilling to maintain ampacity and prevent overheating.

Step 6: Tensioning and Securing For cable tray systems that include tensioned cables (similar to cable railing), install the nonadjustable end first, then cut and attach cables to the adjustable end. Hand-tighten and then use a tensioning tool to achieve proper taut...
