The armored fiber cable is laid directly in the soil inside a trench. A warning tape is typically installed 20–40 cm above the cable. Typical use: rural FTTH backbone, power line corridors, long-distance runs with stable. A direct-burial fiber cable is manufactured and jacketed to be installed straight in the ground without. Depending on site conditions, underground fiber installation typically uses either conduit pulling or direct burial fiber optic cable. Best for urban or high-traffic areas, conduit pulling offers extra protection and easier future upgrades.
