

Can a home fiber optic connection be directly connected to a switch

- Verify Compatibility: Ensure the fiber type matches the SFP module (MMF with MMF SFP, SMF with SMF SFP) to avoid signal loss.
- Optional Media Converter: If your switch lacks SFP ports, use a media converter to connect fiber to standard Ethernet ports.

Installation Considerations

- Bending Radius:** Avoid bending fiber beyond manufacturer recommendations to prevent attenuation or microfractures.
- Outdoor Runs:** Use conduit for protection and bury fiber at least 6–12 inches deep in areas without heavy traffic. For high-traffic areas, deeper burial is recommended.
- Distance:** Multi-mode fiber is suitable for short distances (e.g., house to shed or garage), while single-mode is better for longer runs.
- Star Topology:** For multiple switches, a star topology is recommended.
