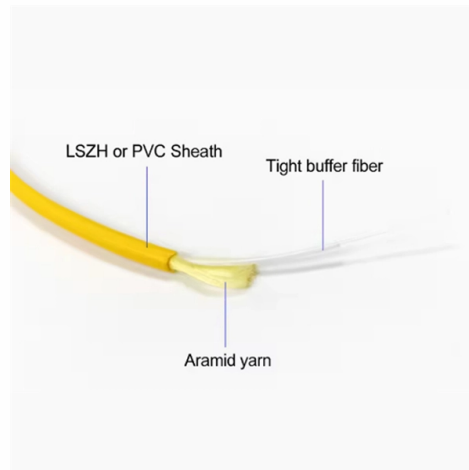


Can a multimode fiber optic disc be used with a single-mode fiber optic cable

- The Impact of Modal Dispersion on. Multimode fiber cabling is used for indoor, short distance applications and single-mode fiber cabling is used for outdoor, long distance application. To connect multimode to single-mode and single-mode to multimode, a fiber-to-fiber media converter is needed to convert multimode to single-mode. Media converters are standalone devices that transform optical signals from one mode to another. How it works: A media converter has two ports: one for SMF and one for MMF.
