

Can an optical modem be connected to a switch

They are commonly used to expand network ports and enable multiple devices to communicate simultaneously.

Key Differences

- Network Layer:** Optical modems operate at the data link layer for signal conversion; switches operate at Layer 2 for packet forwarding.
- Use Case:** Optical modems connect a network to an ISP via fiber; switches manage internal network traffic and expand connectivity.
- Signal Handling:** Optical modems handle modulation/demodulation; switches handle packet switching without changing signal type.
