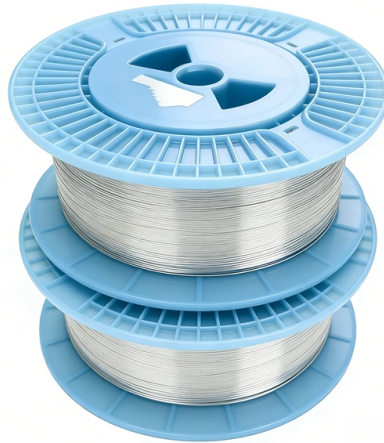


Can fiber optic cables be used to make switches
