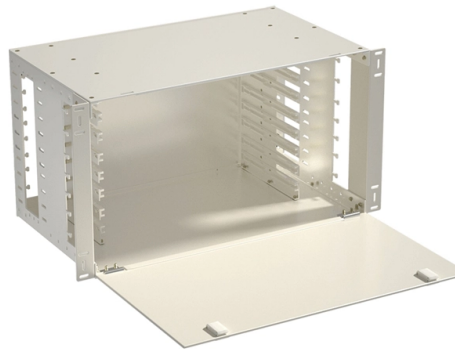


Can parallel lines be connected to a distribution box

Live (L) Wire Connection: In a distribution box setup, the incoming live wire (also known as phase or hot wire, denoted as L or Line) connects to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This serves as the primary source of electrical energy from the mains supply. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs. Each of these 3 phases has an alternating voltage of 230 Volt (or a different voltage.
