Using WebUI Modern switches, such as Cisco Catalyst 9000 series, include an embedded WebUI that visually displays PSU status, port-by-port PoE allocation, and total power usage. This interface allows monitoring without CLI access and provides a quick overview of power distribution and available budget. Physical PSU Checks LED Indicators: "AC OK" indicates stable input voltage. "PS OK" confirms the PSU is delivering proper output. Wattage Labels: Check the PSU label for maximum power (e.g., 350W, 715W, 1100W) to ensure it meets your PoE requirements. Redundant PSUs: For critical deployments, verify that dual PSUs are installed to maintain uptime during maintenance or failures. Best Practices Estimate total PoE load including access points, IP cameras, and VoIP phones, and ensure the PSU wattage is sufficient with 20-30% headroom. Regularly monitor via CLI or WebUI to detect failing PSUs or capacity issues before they impact operations. Align PSU health checks with hardware...
