

Circuit connection of distribution box

A circuit is connected to a distribution box by routing the phase, neutral, and earth wires through the main MCB, RCCB, and individual load MCBs to ensure safe and controlled power distribution. Step-by-Step Connection Process

Turn Off Main Power: Always ensure the main supply is switched off before starting any wiring to prevent electric shock.

Mount the Distribution Box: Secure the box at an accessible height and ensure the installation site is free of obstructions.

Connect Incoming Supply: Attach the incoming live (phase) and neutral wires to the input terminals of the Main MCB. The main MCB acts as the primary isolator.

Connect to RCCB: The output of the Main MCB is connected to the input of the RCCB. The RCCB provides protection against earth leakage.

Connect Load MCBs: For Single Pole MCBs, connect the phase wire from the RCCB output to the MCB input. The neutral wire from the RCCB output is connected to the neutral link in the distribution box. For Double Pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral wires from the RCCB output to the MCB input. The load's phase and neutral wires are connected to the MCB output.

Earth Connection: Connect the earth wire from the supply and all loads to the earth link in the distribution box. Metallic parts of the box should also be earthed.

Label and Test: Clearly mark each circuit for identification. Use a multimeter to verify connections and ensure there are no short circuits.

Safety and Load Considerations

MCB Ratings: Choose MCBs according to the load requirements of each circuit to prevent overloading.
