Cable management racks come in various sizes measured in rack units (U), such as 1U, 2U, 5U, or full-height 42U racks, and are particularly useful for maintaining a maintainable and organized wiring system in server rooms or data centers.

Complementary Use While a cable organizer manages the path and protection of individual cables, a cable management rack provides the structural support for multiple cables and patch panels. Using both together enhances cable management efficiency, reduces maintenance time, and ensures a tidy, safe, and well-cooled network environment.

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
