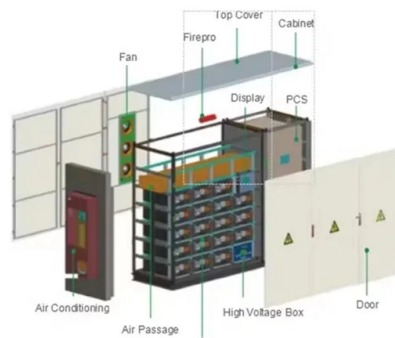

Longer resistance times indicate better fire protection. Firestopping and Penetration Sealing When cable trays pass through walls, floors, or slabs, openings must be sealed with fire-rated materials such as firestop packs, mineral wool, or firestop mastic. Proper sealing prevents fire and smoke from spreading through penetrations. Gaps around cables should be minimal, and cover plates should be installed to maintain a continuous fire barrier.
