Sub-circuit MCBs (Single Pole or Double Pole): Protect individual socket circuits or lighting circuits. Ratings depend on load type, e.g., 13A for standard socket outlets, 16A for AC units. Neutral and Earth Connections: All neutral wires are connected to a neutral bus bar, and all earth wires to an earth bus bar. Proper segregation and secure connections are essential for safety. Connection Procedure Isolate Power: Ensure the main supply is off before starting any wiring. Connect Feeder to Main MCB: Phase and neutral wires from the supply connect to the main MCB input.
