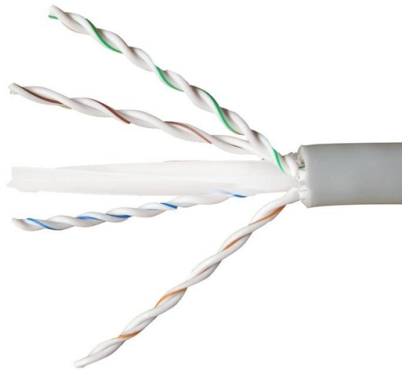

Cable Types for Cable Trays

- Type TC – Tray Cable** Factory-assembled with two or more insulated conductors, optionally including grounding conductors under a non-metallic jacket. Rated for 600 volts, suitable for industrial power or control circuits. Flame-retardant and UL-listed for Class 1, Division 2 hazardous locations. Can be installed in cable trays, raceways, or outdoor locations with messenger wire support. TC-ER variants allow short unsupported transitions between trays and equipment, secured every six feet.
- Type ITC – Instrumentation Tray Cable** Designed for instrumentation and control circuits operating at 150 volts or less and 5 amperes or less. Available in shielded or unshielded constructions, with multiple single conductors or twisted pairs. Sizes range from 22 AWG to 12 AWG. Dual-rated PLTC/ITC cables are available for flexibility in installation. ITC-ER cables require continuous support using mechanical protection and must be secured every six feet.
- Type PLTC – Power-Limited Tray Cable** Intended for non-plenum and non-riser Class 2 and Class 3 circuits. Often dual-rated with ITC for broader application. Requires compliance with power supply listing requirements of NEC Article 725.
- Type MC – Metal-Clad Cable** Assemblies of insulated conductors with or without optical fibers, enclosed in interlocking metal tape or corrugated sheath. Can include a plastic overall jacket. Suitable for indoor and outdoor use, wet or dry locations, hazardous areas, aerial installations, direct burial (where identified), or encased in concrete. Rated for 600 volts and medium voltage applications, used for power, lighting, control, and signaling circuits. Must be supported and secured at intervals not exceeding six feet...
