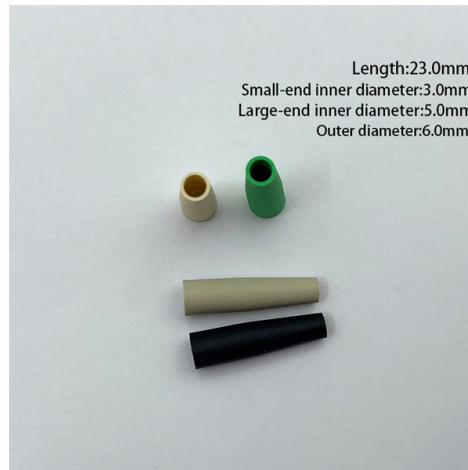

NEMA Type	Description	Typical Use
Type 3	Protects against windblown dust, rain, sleet, snow, and ice formation	General outdoor distribution panels
Type 3R	Protects against rain, sleet, snow; not against windblown dust; ice formation resistant	Outdoor panels in wet locations
Type 3S	Same as 3, but external mechanisms remain operable when ice-laden	Outdoor panels with moving parts
Type 3X	Same as 3, with additional corrosion resistance	Coastal or corrosive environments
Type 4	Protects against splashing water, hose-directed water, and windblown dust	Industrial outdoor applications
Type 4X	Same as Type 4, with enhanced corrosion resistance	Harsh outdoor or chemical environments
Type 6/6P	Protects against temporary or prolonged submersion	Specialized outdoor installations requiring waterproofing

These ratings indicate the enclosure's ability to withstand environmental hazards, but do not specify size or internal configuration. Key Considerations NEC Compliance: Outdoor boxes must be rain-tight in wet locations; specifying only "weatherproof" without a NEMA type can lead to inspectio...
