Continuous monitoring of load distribution is recommended, especially when high inrush current equipment like hydraulic power packs or concrete splitters are used.
- 4. Earthing and Safety:** The distribution box must be properly earthed, and all live parts should be protected against accidental contact. Enclosures should meet at least IP23 protection, preventing water spray and accidental finger contact. Flexible cords entering the box should be anchored and insulated to prevent mechanical damage.
- 5. Labeling and Identification:** Each switch and circuit should be labeled clearly for identification.
