Output to Protective Devices: The output terminals of the main switch feed the RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) or RCD (Residual Current Device), which provides protection against leakage currents, electrical shocks, and insulation faults.

Distribution to Circuit Breakers: From the RCCB, power is distributed to single-pole MCBs for individual circuits such as lighting, sockets, and appliances. For high-power or special loads, double-pole MCBs may be used.

Neutral and Earth Connections: A neutral bus bar distributes the neutral wire to all output circuits, while an earth bus bar connects the supply and load earthing to the grounding system.

Safety and Standards The main switch and distribution box should comply with local standards (e.g., BS EN 61439 in the UK or IEC standards internationally) and be made of non-combustible material. Overvoltage and undervoltage protection can be installed on the main switch to safeguard the system from voltage fluctuations.

Proper circuit labeling is essential for safety and maintenance, identifying each circuit and its corresponding area or appliance.
