Step 5: Configure VLANs Create VLANs to separate network traffic. Assign the fiber optic ports to the appropriate VLANs to ensure proper segmentation and connectivity.

Step 6: Save Configuration Save the running configuration to the switch's memory using the command: `copy running-config startup-config`.
