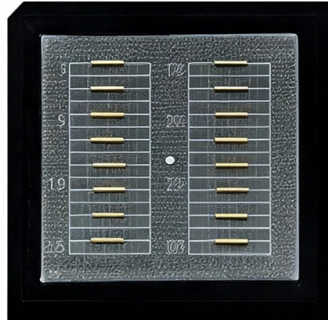

Configure the router: Follow your router's setup instructions, including firmware updates and network security settings, to optimize performance.

Optional network expansion: For larger homes or offices, add mesh Wi-Fi devices or fiber switches to extend coverage and maintain high-speed connectivity.
