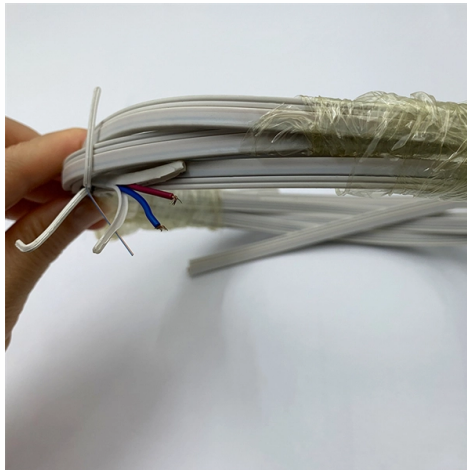


Connect one end to a fiber optic gigabit switch

To connect a fiber optic cable to a gigabit switch, use compatible SFP/SFP+ modules and the correct fiber type with matching connectors. Required Components

Fiber Optic Cable: Choose multi-mode for short distances (up to 550 meters) or single-mode for longer distances. Ensure the cable has the appropriate jacket for indoor or outdoor use if running outside.

Insert SFP Module: Plug the SFP or SFP+ module into the switch's SFP port. These modules are usually hot-swappable.

Attach Fiber Cable: Connect the fiber optic cable to the SFP module, ensuring transmit (TX) goes to receive (RX) on the other end.

Connect to Other Switch or Device: If connecting to another switch, ensure the second switch has a compatible SFP module and fiber type. Use a duplex LC-LC cable for multi-mode connections.

Verify Link: Check the switch's port LEDs or management interface to confirm the fiber link is active.

Best Practices

Clean Connectors: Dust or dirt can degrade signal quality; use fiber cleaning tools before connecting.

Avoid Sharp Bends: Maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent fiber damage.

Outdoor Installation: If running fiber outside, use conduit or armored cable and bury it at a safe depth to protect from physical damage.

Compatibility Check: Ensure both ends use the same fiber type, connector type, and SFP module specifications. Mismatched speeds or duplex settin...
