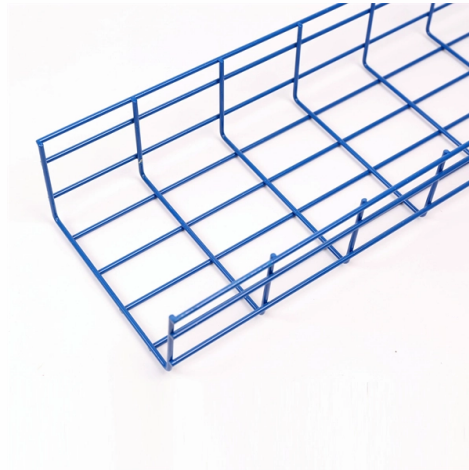


Connecting a portable hard drive to a switch
