

Connecting the fiber optic recharge card to the router

Place both devices near electrical outlets in a dry, ventilated area, ideally protected by a surge suppressor. Power on the router after the ONT has fully booted. Wait for the router's indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 4: Configure and Verify

Most routers automatically detect the fiber connection, but you may need to access the router's web interface (usually 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) for manual setup. Check the ONT and router lights to ensure the internet is active. If the connection fails, verify all cables are secure and the ONT has registered with your ISP's network.

Tips for Optimal Performance

- Avoid bending fiber cables sharply to prevent signal loss.
- Keep the ONT and router away from moisture, heat, or direct sunlight.
- Use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6a or higher) to maintain maximum speeds.
