

Connecting the fiber optic router to the SFP interface

Step 3: Install the SFP Module

Remove the SFP module from its anti-static packaging. Align the module with the router's SFP port, ensuring TX/RX labels match the cable direction. Gently push the module into the slot until it clicks and is secured by the latch. Some devices support hot-swapping, but it is generally safer to install with the router powered off.

Step 4: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable

Insert the fiber optic cable into the SFP module, taking care not to bend or damage the fibers. Ensure the connectors are fully seated and aligned with the module's ports.

Step 5: Power On and Configure

Turn on the router and check the SFP module's status indicators (usually a green LED for active link). If connecting through an ONT, link the ONT to the router via Ethernet if required.
