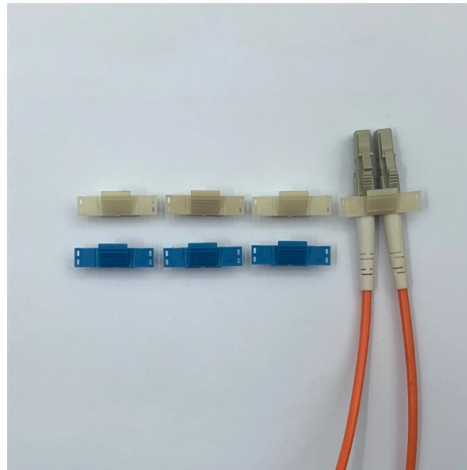


Connecting the optical router to the switch



AI Overview

To connect an optical switch (ONT) to a router, use an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port, ensuring proper placement, power sequencing, and cable quality for optimal fiber performance.

Required Equipment

- Install the ONT:** Locate the fiber entry point in your home. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated port. Plug in the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network.
- Connect the ONT to the Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN or Ethernet port to the router's WAN port, which is often labeled and color-coded. Ensure the router is powered on after the ONT has fully booted to allow proper network registration.
- Router Configuration:** Once connected, check the router's indicator lights to confirm internet connectivity. Configure Wi-Fi settings, security protocols, and firmware updates for optimal performance.

Best Practices

- Device Placement:** Keep both ONT and router near power outlets, in a dry, ventilated area, and away from extreme temperatures or moisture.
- Cable Quality:** Use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6a or better) to preserve fiber speeds and reduce latency.
- Power Sequencing:** Always power the ONT first, then the router, to ensure proper network initialization.
- Network Optimization:** For large homes or high-demand setups, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems or routers supporting Wi-Fi 6/7 for bet...
