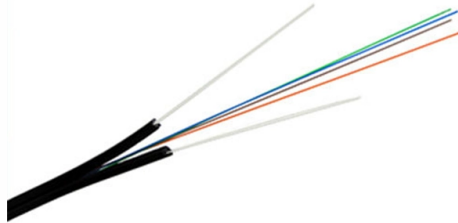

D-ring type: Install similarly to horizontal managers, aligning with rack holes and securing with screws.

Bend radius fingers and finger ducts: Hang the frame in positioning holes, drag downward to lock, and tighten screws. These designs help maintain proper bend radius, preventing cable stress and signal degradation.
