- Volume Pricing:** Larger projects often reduce the per-splice cost. For example, a contractor may charge \$100 per splice for a small 24-fiber job but only \$55 per splice for a 288-fiber project.
- Mobilization and Travel:** Local mobilization fees typically range from \$150–\$500, with remote sites adding more to the total cost.
- Equipment Considerations** Fusion splicers cost \$3,000–\$15,000, and precision cleavers range from \$500–\$2,000. These tools are essential for high-quality splicing and are factored into labor rates.
