- 1. Modular Architecture and Scalability** Micro-module data centers typically use containerized units to house critical infrastructure, including UPS systems, battery cabinets, HVAC, and power distribution units. This approach allows for rapid deployment, flexible expansion, and efficient space utilization, as demonstrated by CHINT's T3-level data center in Manila, which used 40-foot and 20-foot containers for electromechanical equipment and transformers. Modular design also supports phased growth, enabling operators to scale IT loads incrementally.
- 2. Site Selection and Risk Mitigation** Strategic location is crucial. Projects like A-FLOW's ML1 in Laguna are sited in areas with low geological and flood risks, ensuring operational continuity. For larger campuses, New Clark City in Tarlac was chosen for its master-planned environment, contiguous land parcels, and reliable utility infrastructure, which supports both hyperscale and modular deployments.
- 3. Energy Efficiency and Sustainability** Micro-module data centers prioritize low Power Usage Effectiveness (PUE) and green standards. CHINT's project achieved a PUE of 1.3, emphasizing energy-efficient power distribution, precision cooling, and integration of low-carbon solutions. Advanced designs may also incorporate waste heat recovery, water recirculation, and renewable energy sources, following global precedents like Singapore's NEWater program and Denmark's Kalundborg Symbiosis.
- 4. Connectivity and Carrier Neutrality** Ensuring robust network connectivity is essential. Facilities like ML1 provide multiple Points-of-Entry (PoE) for route redundancy, supporting colocation, enterprise, and cloud service pro...
