- Test Voltage:** Place the probes on the terminals of the breaker or wires you want to test. A reading close to the expected voltage confirms power is on. A reading of 0 volts indicates no power.
- Double-Check:** If readings are inconsistent, ensure probes are properly connected and the correct voltage range is selected.

Additional Tips Always turn off the main breaker if you need to remove cover plates or touch wiring. Identify circuits by labels or by turning breakers off one by one to isolate the area you want to test. If unsure or uncomfortable, call a licensed electrician to avoid risk of shock or damage. By combining breaker position checks with multimeter verification, you can safely determine whether power is on in your distribution box.
