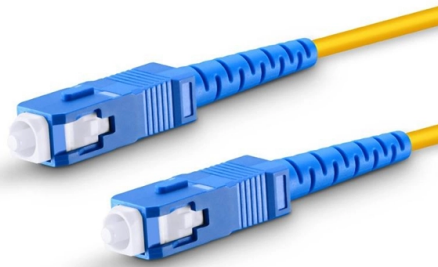


Disassemble the FC interface cable



Overview

LC Connectors: Press the latch mechanism and gently pull the connector out.
