Common symbols include: Fragile - Handle with Care: Indicates delicate contents. This Way Up: Shows the correct upright position. Keep Dry: Indicates moisture-sensitive items. Do Not Stack: Prevents placing weight on top of the box. These symbols help ensure regulatory compliance, safe transport, and consumer trust across international shipping. Compliance and Legal Considerations Only use registered trademarks with the proper symbols (® for registered marks, ™ for unregistered marks) as specified by the brand. Follow the brand's distributor agreement; if the agreement ends, the right to use the brand marks is revoked. Ensure packaging meets minimum protection standards to preve...
