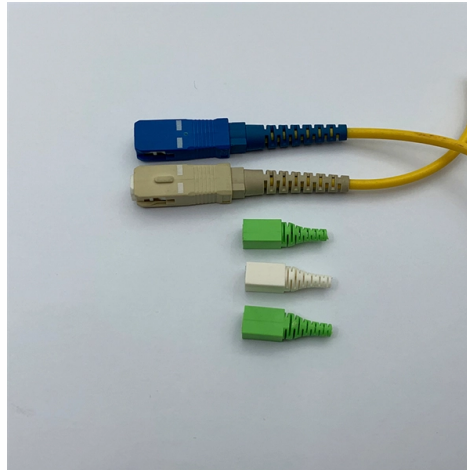

In practical fibers, the cladding is usually coated with a layer of acrylate polymer or polyimide.
