Direct Connection to ONT Technically, it is possible to connect a device directly to the ONT's Ethernet output, bypassing a router. This can provide faster speeds and lower latency for a single device. However, this setup has limitations: Only one or a few devices can connect, as most ONTs have limited Ethernet ports. Network management features like Wi-Fi, firewall protection, and Quality of Service (QoS) are unavailable. Security risks increase because the router's firewall is bypassed. ISP restrictions may prevent or limit direct connections.
