Connection Steps

- Insert SFP Modules:** Install compatible SFP modules into the fiber ports of both switches.
- Connect Duplex Cable:** Cross-connect the fibers: the TX port on Switch A goes to the RX port on Switch B, and vice versa.
- Verify Link:** Check the link lights on both switches to ensure the connection is active.
- Configure Switch Settings (Optional):** Some switches may require enabling the fiber port or setting the correct duplex and speed modes.

Best Practices

- Match Fiber Type and Wavelength:** Both ends must use the same fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and compatible wavelengths to avoid signal loss.
- Use Pre-Terminated Cables:** Pre-terminated duplex cables save installation time and reduce errors.
- Limit Cascading Layers:** When connecting multiple switches, avoid cascading more than four layers to maintain performance.
- Clean Connectors:** Always clean fiber connectors before insertion to prevent signal degradation.
