Neutral and Grounding Links: Ensure proper return paths for current and safe dissipation of excess electricity to the ground, preventing shocks and fire hazards. Enclosure: Protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage. Electrical Flow Process Incoming Supply: Electricity enters the DB through the main supply line, connecting first to the main MCB or main switch. Distribution via Busbars: The main MCB feeds power to the busbars, which act as a central hub for distributing electricity to multiple circuits. Circuit Protection: Each branch circuit is connected to its own MCB or fuse, which limits current flow to safe levels. If a fault occurs, the breaker trips or the fuse blows, isolating the affected circuit. RCCB Protection: The RCCB mo...
