- Breaker Selection and Configuration:** 1P breakers disconnect only the live conductor, suitable for standard lighting and single-phase loads. 2P breakers disconnect both line and neutral, providing higher safety for maintenance or fault conditions. For three-phase systems, use 3P or 4P breakers to protect all phases simultaneously.
- Cable Management:** Route wires neatly along DIN rails or cable entry points to avoid tangling and facilitate maintenance. Use proper wire gauge according to load requirements and breaker ratings. Label all circuits clearly for easy identification during inspections or upgrades.
- Safety and Compliance:** Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor. Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC) and use UL/CE-certified components. Perform...
